Sabina Woods (and daughters)

SW Worked as housekeeper for a dentist, in an enclave off Preston New Road - 1928 to 1939 (est.)

Gordon Gilmore - significant locations

GG1 St Georges Presbyterian Church, Preston New Road - the place I wasn't baptized in
 GG2 St James Primary School, St James Road
 GG3 Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School, West Park Road
 GG4 Belper St Baths - we were sent there from St James and expected to learn to swim
 GG5 The Corporation Park - location of many, many hours of exploration
 GG6 Holt's Chemists - he allowed me to spend my pocket money on increasingly serious and potentially dangerous chemicals.
